### ***HATS***

Hawkesdale P12 College is a **Sun Smart School**. This program is sponsored by the Anti Cancer Council and endorsed by the Department of Education and Training. The policy requires all students and staff to wear a hat at all times when outdoors during the summer months. Hence all students are required to wear a hat during Term One and Term Four. If students are without a hat they will be required to spend their recess and lunchtime under shelter. If their class is outside for an activity and they are without a hat they will not be able to participate in the activity and alternative arrangements will be made for the duration of the lesson.
